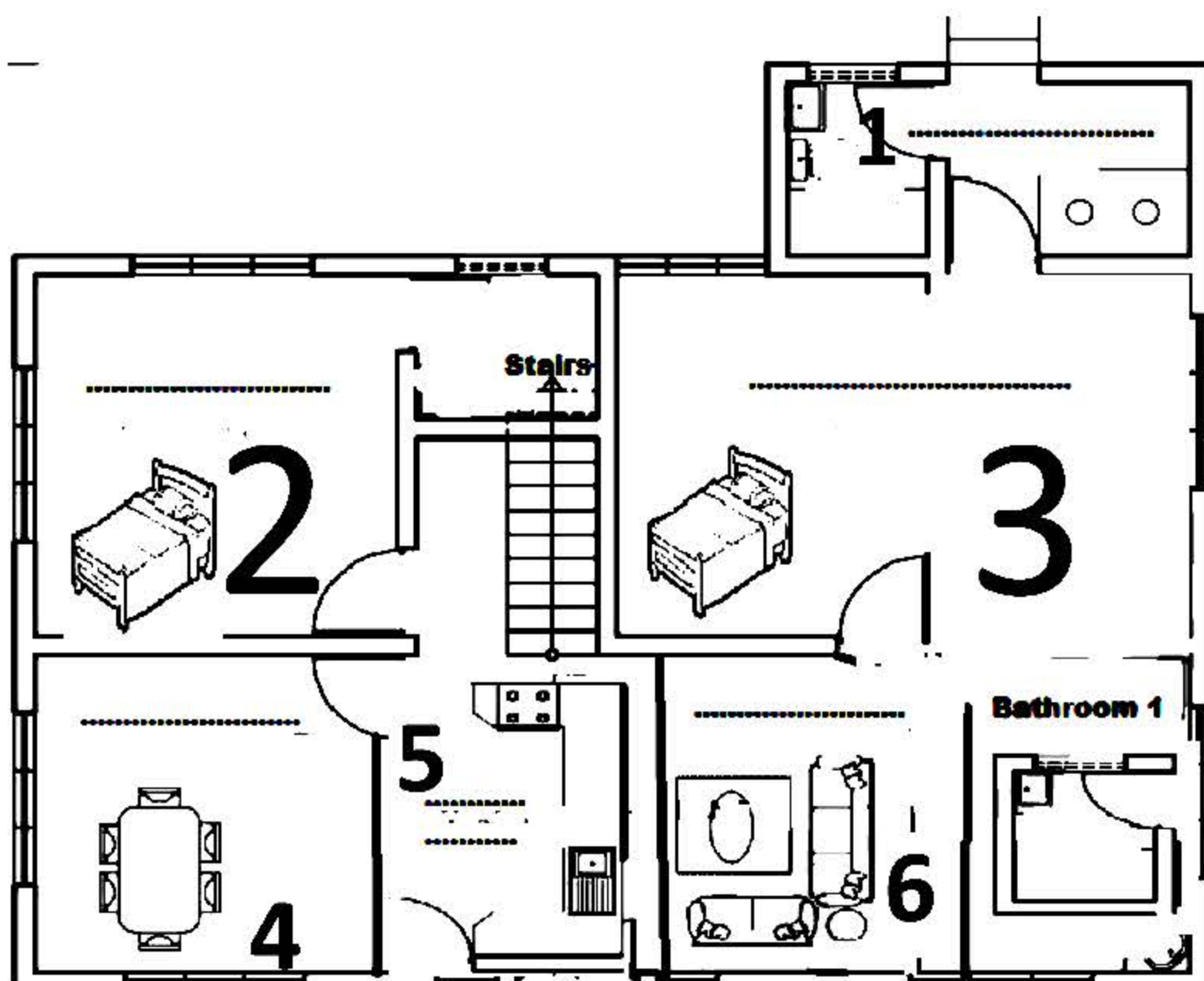
Hello, my name is Jennifer, and I am from New York. I live in a big house. It has two floors.
