# "The Statue of Liberty"

On July 1884, France gave the United States a gift to celebrate the one hundred years of independence. It was the Statue of Liberty which is considered



as one of the most famous American landmarks. The statue is of a robed female figure representing Libertas, the Roman goddess of freedom.

The Liberty Statue standing in New York harbour was built in France by the sculptor Frederic August Bartholdi. The project took nine years and was finally completed in 1884. It was made of thin copper. The Statue of Liberty is ninety-three meters high and weighs two hundred and twenty-five tons.

Today, it is a universal symbol of freedom. It attracts around 10.000 visitors per day, that's about 4.24 million per year!
