



Comparatives of superiority, inferiority, equality and inequality:

Short adjective + er + than

A plane is bigger than a helicopter.

more + long adjective + than

Travelling by plane is **more** expensive **than** travelling by train.

Countable plural nouns: many / few / fewer.

Uncountable nouns: much / little / less.

- When he started learning English he made **many** mistakes.
- Now he makes only **few** mistakes. He makes **fewer** mistakes **than** before.
- He is not rich. He hasn't got **much** money. He's got only **little** money. Actually, he's got **less** money **than** the required minimum to live.
