





• Keep in mind:

- **1-** UNDER, BELOW, ABOVE and OVER are prepositions of place or location.
 - **Under** means vertically below.
 - **Below** means lower than.
- eg: There was snow **under** our feet.

 From the hills we could see the valley **below** us.
 - above means higher than.
 - over means vertically above.

eg: The high buildings in New York rise above the passers-by.

There was a valuable painting over the chimney.

- **2-** FROM, UNTIL, FROM / TO are prepositions of time.
- From is used with the starting point of an action. It is usually found with until (or to) which indicates the end of an action.

eg: He was in hospital from January until April.
