Human Skeletal System

The skeletal system consists of all the bones of the body plus the joints where the bones attach to each other. Bone and cartilage, two types of connective tissue, are the major tissues of the system. The skeletal system supports the soft tissues of the body. Its bones protect the structures enclosed by them. Bones and joints, acting as levers, work with muscles to provide movement.

Useful elements such as calcium are stored in bones.

Red blood cells are produced in the red marrow of bones.

The two main parts of the human skeleton are the axial skeleton and the appendicular skeleton.


