At the age of 40 ,while he was praying in Hira Cave, he received the revelation through the Angel Gabriel who told him that he was the prophet of Allah.

Thirteen years later, the prophet Mohamed (peace be upon him) ordered his companions to leave Mecca and to go to Medina. He travelled with his friend, Abu Baker. Their enemies tried to stop them but they did not succeed. This long and difficult trip called the Hijra. The prophet and God's messenger, Mohamed (peace be upon him) died in 632.
